Your Journey to Understanding, Peace and Reconciliation

Day 1 and 2 - USA to the Holy Land

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your hotel in the Galilee. Enjoy dinner before you rest.

Day 3 – Caesarea Philippi, Golan Heights, Road to Damascus, Bira’am, Galilee Boat Ride, Capernaum, Tabgha, Mt. of Beatitudes

Visit **Caesarea Philippi**, where Jesus traveled with His disciples and where Peter made his great confession to Jesus, “Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God” (Matt. 16: 16). Continue on to **Mount Hermon**, a possible site of the Lord’s Transfiguration (Matt. 17: 1-9). Travel on through the strategic tableland known as the **Golan Heights** to see the **Road to Damascus**. It was along this road that Paul had his conversion experience. Visit the Christian village of **Bira’am**. Travel to **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus’ ministry in the Galilee. Visit the synagogue which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt.4: 13, 23). With Bible in hand, cross the waters of the **Sea of Galilee** aboard a Kinnereth Sailing Company boat. Along the way, participate in a special on board worship service. Travel to the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus preached to the people (Matt. 5-7). At **Tabgha**, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the **Church of the Loaves and the Fishes** (Luke 9:10-17). Overnight in Tiberias.

Day 4- Ibillin - Bishop Elias Chacour, Mt. Carmel, Nazareth

Travel north to visit the remarkable school on a hill that began with the hands and sweat of one man and through his vision has blossomed into an educational complex of excellence. Bishop Elias Chacour has made the little village of **Ibillin** world famous as a center for peace and learning. Above the city of Haifa is **Mt. Carmel**, where Elijah defeated the Baal prophets (1 Kings 18:25). You'll visit the monastery at the top of the mountain. Visit **Nazareth**, the

boyhood home of Jesus, continue to Jerusalem for overnight.

Day 5- Princess Basma Hospital, Mt. of Olives, Bethany, Jericho, Qumran, Dead Sea

Visit the **Princess Basma Center for Disabled Children**. Stand atop the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the “Golden City” of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. On the far side of the Mount of Olives is **Bethany**, home of Mary, Martha and Lazareth (John 11:1). Jesus often stayed here. It was here that he taught Martha the better way (Luke 10:38-42) and raised Lazarus from the dead (John 11:1-44). Travel the road from Jerusalem to Jericho which twists for miles as it weaves through the Judean mountains and descends below sea level. Jesus traveled the nearby Roman road, the setting of His parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10: 30-36). Visit the ruins of the ancient **Jericho**, which was conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6: 1, 2, 20). From Jericho, you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matt. 4: 1-11). Travel to **Qumran**, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Time permitting; you'll stop briefly at the Shores of the **Dead Sea** for a quick dip in the salt and mineral laden waters.

Day 6 –Sabeel Center, Western Wall, Temple Mount, St. Ann Church, Ecco Homo Arch, Via Dolorosa, Church of the Holy Sepulchre

Visit the staff at the **Christian Peace Center, Sabeel**. Continue to the **Southern Wall Excavations** of the Temple including the **Teaching Steps** and the **Western Wall**. View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle, and sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne**. Visit **Herod’s Antonia Fortress** (lithostratos) where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1 - 11). Walk the **Via Dolorosa**, “the Way of the Cross”, and stand in reverence at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**.

Day 7 – Palm Sunday Walk, Garden of Gethsemane, Kidron Valley, Mt. Zion, House of Caiaphas, Upper Room, Garden Tomb

View the **Kidron Valley** as you walk the **Palm Sunday Path**. Pray in the **Garden of Gethsemane** as Jesus prayed (Matt.26: 36 - 44). On **Mount Zion** visit the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas** where Jesus was imprisoned for a night (Matt. 26: 57 - 65). Stand in the **Upper Room**, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14: 12 - 26). Visit and worship at the **Garden Tomb**, possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea. In this quiet place, it is easy to experience the reality of the Resurrection.

Day 8 - Worship East Jerusalem Baptist Church, Bethlehem

Begin your morning by worshiping at the East Jerusalem Baptist Church. Cross the border into **Bethlehem**, the birthplace of Jesus (Luke 2). Enter the **Church of the Nativity**, the oldest continuously functioning church in the world. See the cave where tradition holds Jesus was born. Look out on the **Shepherds’ Field**, where angels spread the Good News. This evening, you'll meet with Christians who live in the area and learn of their daily experiences.

Day 9 Bethlehem: Bible College, Hope Secondary School, Yad Vashem

The Good News continues to be heard at the **Bethlehem Bible College** founded in 1979 by **Bishara** and **Alex Awad** to prepare students for Christian service in the Middle East. Visit the **Hope Secondary School**, which provides spiritual, academic, and physical growth for 140 Christian and Muslim students. Visit **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Museum.

Day 10 - Return to USA

Travel home a changed person.

Cairo and the Route of the Exodus

7-day* extension \$898

Day 10 Early morning departure from Jerusalem. Cross the Sinai, traveling ancient caravan routes across the **Sinai** to the base of **Mt. Sinai** for overnight.

Day 11 Visit the **Monastery of Saint Catherine** at the base of **Mount Sinai**. Trace the route of the Exodus along the eastern Sinai coast to **Wadi Feiran** where the Children of Israel withstood the Amalekites. Travel to **Elim** where the Children of Israel camped by the oasis of 70 palm trees. Your final stop of the day will be **Marah** by the **Red Sea** where the "waters were bitter." Continue to **Cairo** for dinner and a four night stay.

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** (Biblical Noph) and on to **Sakkara** where you will see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**.

Day 13 Travel south to view **Joseph's River and Lake**, created by Joseph during the period of the seven years of famine. Visit a **grain silo** of the kind established under Joseph's rule to store grain during the seven years of famine. Tour the rural region of traditional Egyptian farming and stop at an **old corn water mill**.

Day 14 Admire the ancient treasures of the **Egyptian Museum**.

Day 15 Continue to the Sinai for overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Wonders of Jordan and Petra

3-day extension \$598

Day 10 In the morning, you will cross the Allenby Bridge into Jordan. View the "promised land" as Moses did from the summit of **Mt. Nebo**. Nearby **Madaba** is home to a beautiful 6th century mosaic of Jerusalem. Visit Philadelphia, one of the ten cities of the Decapolis, and now **Amman**.

Day 11 Early in the morning you'll journey to the famous rock city of **Petra**, literally cut into the cliff sides. Return to Amman for a late dinner and overnight.

Day 12 Explore the ruins of **Jerash**, Jordan's best-preserved Greco-Roman town. Depart the Holy Land this evening.

Day 13 Arrive in the USA.

Wonders of Egypt and Luxor

7-day extension \$1298

Day 10 Early morning departure from Jerusalem. Cross the Sinai, traveling ancient caravan routes across the **Sinai** to the base of **Mt. Sinai** for overnight.

Day 11 Visit the **Monastery of Saint Catherine** at the base of **Mount Sinai**. Trace the route of the Exodus along the eastern Sinai coast to **Wadi Feiran** where the Children of Israel withstood the Amalekites. Travel to **Elim** where the Children of Israel camped by the oasis of 70 palm trees. Your final stop of the day will be **Marah** by the **Red Sea** where the "waters were bitter." Day 13 & 14 (Lunches included on these days.) Cross the Nile River to visit the **Valley of Kings and Queens**. After overnight in Luxor, visit the magnificent **Karnak Temple** and the **Luxor Temple**. Fly to **Cairo**.

Day 15 Admire the ancient treasures of the **Egyptian Museum**. Continue to the Sinai for overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

*Note: The Cairo Route of the Exodus Extension and the Egypt Luxor Extension will operate together on Days 10-12
