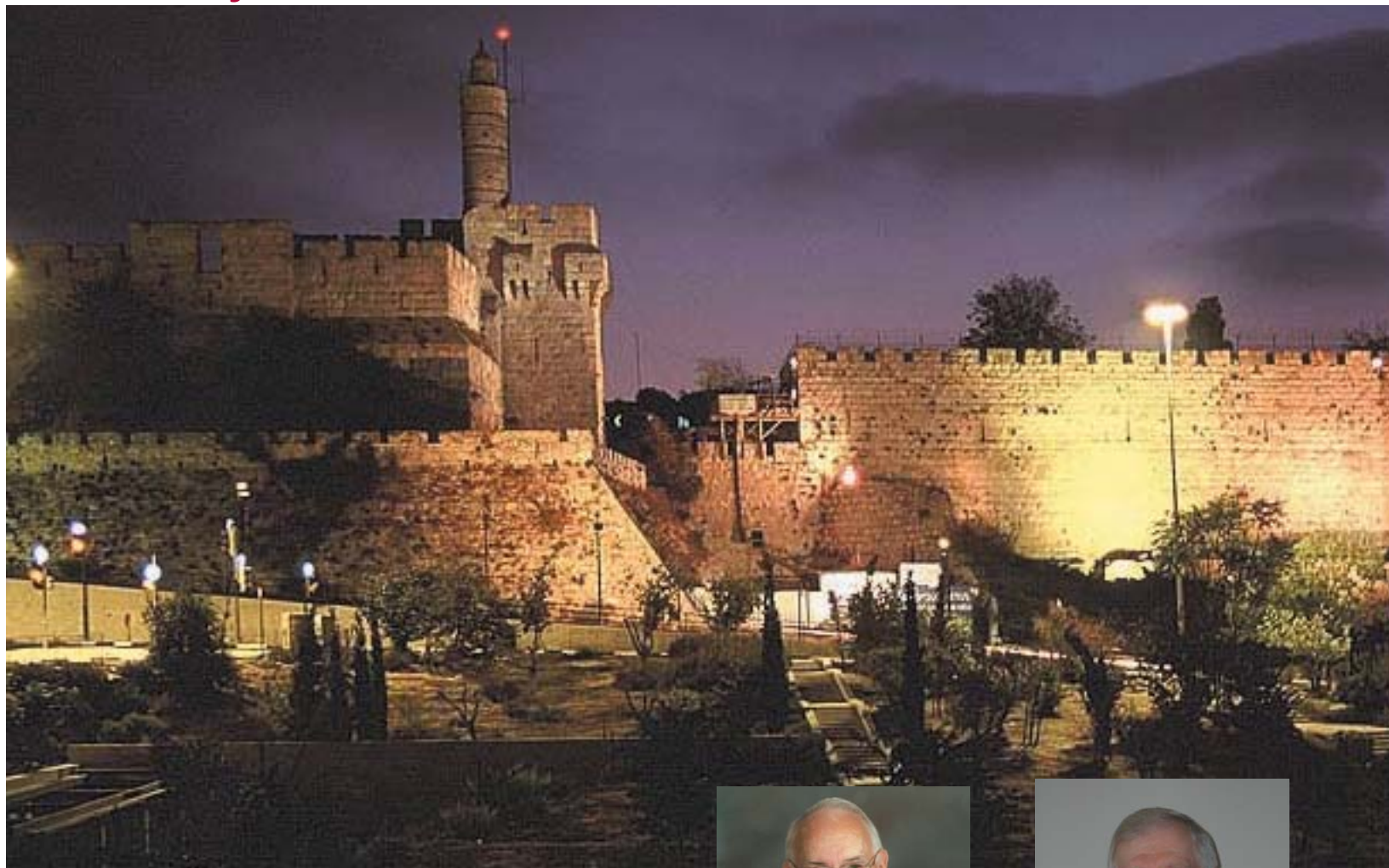

Cairo and the Route of the Exodus

7-day* extension \$898

Day 10 Early morning departure from Jerusalem. Cross the Sinai, traveling ancient caravan routes across the **Sinai** to the base of **Mt. Sinai** for overnight.

Day 11 Visit the **Monastery of Saint Catherine** at the base of **Mount Sinai**. Trace the route of the Exodus along the eastern Sinai coast to **Wadi Feiran** where the Children of Israel withstood the Amalekites. Travel to **Elim** where

the Children of Israel camped by the oasis of 70 palm trees. Your final stop of the day will be **Marah** by the **Red Sea** where the "waters were bitter." Continue to **Cairo** for dinner and a four night stay.

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** (Biblical Noph) and on to **Sakkara** where you will see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**.

Day 13 Travel south to view **Joseph's River and Lake**, created by Joseph during the period of the seven years of famine. Visit a **grain silo** of the kind established under Joseph's rule to store grain during the seven years of famine. Tour the rural region of traditional Egyptian farming and stop at an **old corn water mill**.

Day 14 Admire the ancient treasures of the **Egyptian Museum**.

Day 15 Continue to the Sinai for overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Day 10 -11 Your itinerary is the same as the Cairo and the Route of the Exodus (see above).

Day 12 This morning you will enjoy a half day tour of **Cairo**, including the **Egyptian Museum**, the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**. This afternoon you will fly to Aswan where you will board your Nile Cruise boat.

Day 13 Visit the **High Dam of Aswan** and the **Granite Quarry** where you

can see the **Unfinished Obelisk**. Visit the **Temple of Philae** before sailing to the beautiful **Temple of Kom Ombo**. After your visit to the temple shared by two gods, your cruise continues along the **Nile**.

Day 14 Visit the **Temple of Horus** in **Edfu**. Continue via the **Nile Lock** and sail to **Luxor**.

Day 15 Disembark and cross to the Western Bank where you will visit the **Necropolis of Thebes**, the **Valley of the Kings and Queens**, the **Temple of Hatshepsut** and the **Colossi of Memnon**. On the East Bank, you'll visit the amazing **Temples of Luxor and Karnak**. Fly back to **Cairo** for dinner and overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.
